

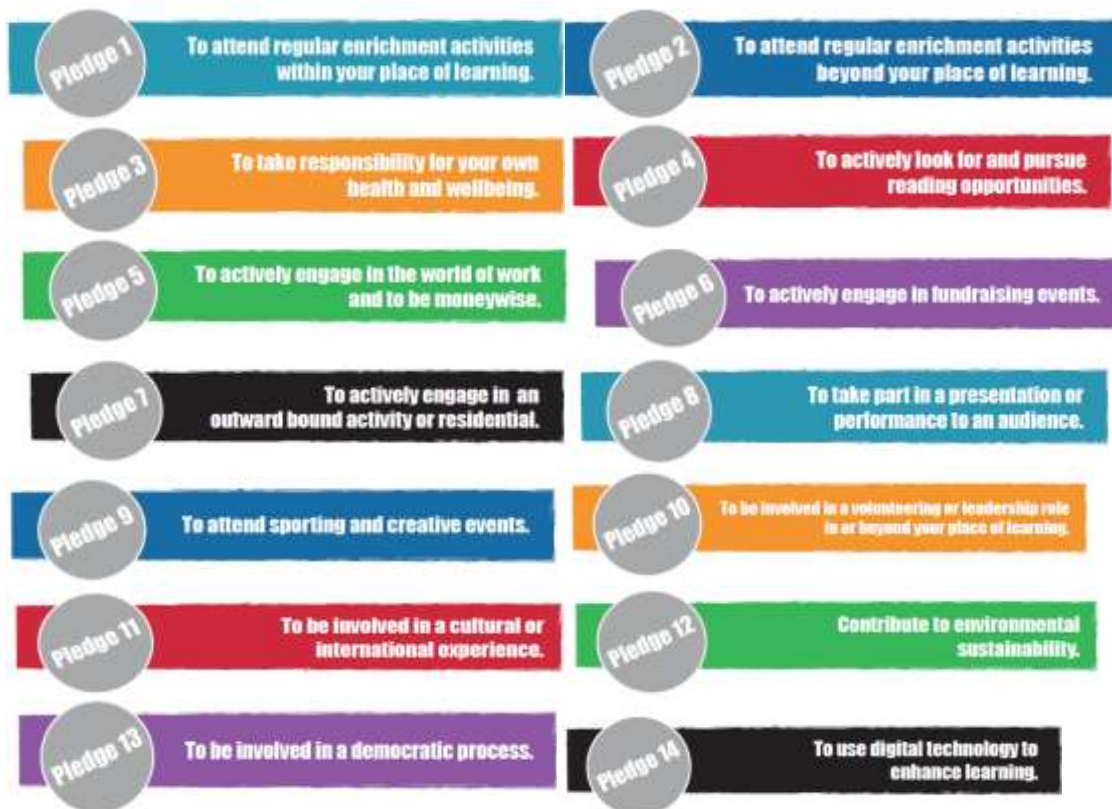


St Hilda's School have now joined The Oldham Pledge Initiative.

The Oldham Pledge is a direct action from the Oldham Education and Skills Commission Report and highlights the importance of supporting all children and young people to grow into well rounded confident citizens who can succeed as individuals and contribute to their community.

The Pledge focuses on developing a range of skills through a breadth of experiences (the 14 pledges) for their future.



The children receive a passport to fill in with all the activities they have done that contribute towards the pledge.
